Aztec Echoes: Unveiling Mexico City

January 31 | Mexico City

Upon arrival in Mexico City, we'll be welcomed by our English speaking guide who will assist us with our group transfer (*time to be advised*). Check in to our hotel Hampton Inn & Suites by Hilton (4 star) to relax and unwind.. Tonight our guide will walk us to a vintage Restaurant Café de Tacuba, a shrine to the country's culinary traditions. Enjoy a 3 course meal and an alcoholic beverage - a perfect start to the trip.

February 1 | Mexico City

Our day begins with a tour of Mexico City. We explore magnificent Mexico City, built on top of the ruins of the Aztec capital of Tenochtitlan. Our first stop is the Zocalo, one of the biggest public squares in the

world. We visit the murals of Diego Rivera followed by a visit to the Metropolitan Cathedral – the biggest church in Latin America, and see the Templo Mayor (from the outside). We drive along famous boulevard Paseo de la Reforma. We continue to visit the Museum of Anthropology, where we will have time to explore the treasures of Aztec culture. Finally, we visit Chapultepec Park, one of the most famous parks in Mexico City and of great historical importance for Mexicans. Tonight we dine at Restaurant Azulísimo within walking distance of our hotel. Chef Zurita is considered the greatest in Mexican cuisine and has traveled through Mexico studying cuisines and converting them into an intangible heritage recognized by UNESCO. Enjoy a 3 course meal with an alcoholic beverage.

February 2 | Mexico City

After breakfast, we drive to the impressive archaeological site of Teotihuacan, located 50 km northeast of Mexico City. On the way we stop at the "Plaza de las Tres Culturas", where three

cultures converge: Aztec, Spanish, and contemporary Mexican. We continue to the Shrine de Guadalupe, Latin America's most revered religious shrine. We then drive to Teotihuacan, one of the most impressive cities of the ancient world, held sacred by the Aztecs. We will explore its temples, palaces and pyramids, including the Quetzalpapalotl Palace, the Pyramid of the Moon, and the immense Pyramid of the Sun.

This afternoon we continue our trip to Ixtapan or group transfer to the airport for our onward journey.
