THU 23 NOV - Day 2: Istanbul

After buffet breakfast, there is a full day guided tour which includes St. Sophia, the cathedral built by Emperor Justinian in 537 (the largest church in Christendom), the Byzantine Hippodrome with its various monuments including a 3500-year-old red granite obelisk from Egypt, erected here in 390 AD. The Ottoman Empire produced marvelous architecture and you'll see two of its finest works: Topkapi Palace, home of the sultans, and the famed Blue Mosque of Sultan Ahmet I. Our Thanksgiving lunch

will be at world famous Sultanahmet Koftecisi Restaurant in the old souk. Afterwards s we venture into the labyrinthine Grand Bazaar. Transfer back to our hotel for overnight.

FRI 24 NOV - Day 3: Istanbul

After breakfast, visit stunning Kariye museum with some of the world's greatest mosaics. We drive to Eminönü for the aromatic Spice Bazaar, where smells of cinnamon, cloves and thyme, rise from hundreds of muslin bags at every store-front. Then have a Bosphorus Cruise, the waterway separating Europe and Asia, see marble palaces, ancient wooden villas of Ottoman architecture and modern residential luxurious apartments. Finally visit Dolmabahce Palace, most luxurious architecture from the Ottoman era. Lunch at a local restaurant.

Optional visit: an opportunity to use the former Royal hamman in the afternoon or early evening. We went on a prior trip, were scrubbed soaped and bathed on marble beds. We then enjoyed tea and Turkish snacks. All agreed it was a fantastic experience. Transfer hotel price of hamman includes transfers;

SAT 25 NOV - Day 4: Istanbul

After buffet breakfast continue to visit both the old and new in modern Istanbul. Begin with a stroll through exciting Taksim, the heart of modern Istanbul. Here see young and hip, artists and businessmen rubbing shoulders. Next stop is Beyoglu. This area is enjoying a cultural and architectural revival thriving with fashion, art, restaurants and night clubs. Zig-zag across the Istiklal Caddesi (the Grande Rue) a popular pedestrian boulevard known as Paris of the east. Explore back streets and see a variety of funky cafes before stopping to enjoy a traditional Turkish coffee. Then we see Galatasaray Square, site of the first European inspired High School and Cicek Pasaji (Flower Passage), a shrine to the Turks' love of leisurely dining. Stop by Balik Bazaar - a local market specializing in seafood and perhaps try some fresh

battered and fried mussels. End at the Galata Tower with its wonderful views of Istanbul. Finish with a ride on the Tunell funicular, enjoy a stroll through Karakoy and catch a tram back to Sultanahmet.

SUN 26 NOV - Day 5: Istanbul

Cisterns Tour in morning. This is Istanbul's newest huge attraction. The cisterns carried millions of gallons of water to the growing city from the 4th century. You will be awe struck at their size and beauty and how buildings in 300's created the aqueducts and cisterns. PM at leisure.

MON 27 NOV - Day 6 Istanbul (B,D)

Day at leisure. Istanbul offers one of the best shopping anywhere. Ask us if you wish an optional shopping tour. Jewelry, carpets, ceramics, fabulous clothing, leather goods, gems. We do not usually offer shopping but Istanbul is the exception. Tonight farewell dinner in a local restaurant.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellations received 90 days to 60 days prior to departure: 50% non-refundable. Within 60 days of departure 100% of the tour price is nonrefundable. We strongly advise you purchase travel insurance to safeguard your travel investments. If you change to a single from a share and we cannot replace your share, we will bill you \$400 to protect your intended share. Please refer to SITA's website for other applicable details.
