3 Days – Pre Tour visiting Zagreb, Plitvice Lakes, Zadar

Tour Overview

Our relaxing journey starts in Croatia's capital, Zagreb and then on to the lakes and waterfalls of Plitvice Lakes National Park. We enjoy a visit to Zadar, before joining the group in Split. This tour sold out last time we offered it. Some of the tours are for our group only and some are offered by the cruise line for all guests. Both the pre and post tour have minimum numbers needed for private tours; we offer them this way to guarantee the pre and post will operate. Our ship will be a Premium Superior ship, MV Moonlight. The chef is also known for very good food.

Day 1 – Oct 11 2022 - Zagreb (Dinner)

Arrive in Zagreb and transfer to the hotel (driving time 20 to 45 min). The rest of the day is at leisure. This evening meet with our tour guide for a pre-tour briefing and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Zagreb. **Accommodation: Hotel Esplanade Zagreb (2 Nights).** <https://www.esplanade.hr/>

Day 2 – Oct 12 2022 - Zagreb (B)

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of Zagreb with an English speaking guide. In the fortified, medieval Upper Town, visit St. Mark's church, with its multicolor tiled roof, Parliament, the government palace, and many fine old buildings. Afternoon at leisure

Day 3 – Oct 13 2022 - Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning depart for the beautiful Plitvice Lakes National Park, consisting of 16 lakes, connected with a series of waterfalls. Take a walk through the park, enjoy a boat ride on the emerald green Kozjak Lake and ride the street train back to the entrance. Walking shoes are essential for our 2 hour walk in this wonderful environment. **Overnight in Plitvice Lakes**

Day 4 – Oct 14 2022 - Plitvice Lakes – Zadar – Split (Breakfast, Tasting, Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel, we drive down from the mountain region of Lika via the coast towards the city of Zadar. The historic town of Zadar is rich in cultural and historical monuments. Here you can see the Roman forum dated to the 1st century AD, the church of St. Donatus dated to the 9th century AD. Of special interest are the famous Zadar Sea Organs, one of a kind in the world. From Zadar we continue to the Sladic Winery for a gourmet experience that is more than a simple wine tasting. We will taste the Dalmatian Debit white wine and Cuvée of Shiraz & Merlot, accompanied with delicious Croatian style

Tapas. Continue on towards Split and check in at **Hotel Coronaro**, where we join the group for our welcome briefing & Dinner.

11 Days: SPLIT - MAKARSKA - (BOL) STARI GRAD - HVAR - BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE)/ VIS - KORČULA - (MLJET) ŠIPAN OR SLANO - DUBROVNIK

Tour Overview

Board our ship in Split, a monumental city under UNESCO protection featuring an abundance of Roman architecture. Cruise the Dalmatian coast of the southern Adriatic Sea, hugging the coast and island hopping with stops along the way to Dubrovnik, the highlight of our journey. Enjoy the amazing sights of nature as we cruise from one island to another. The evenings are at leisure to enjoy a good restaurant or to discover old churches and other historical monuments. Visit Montenegro and the Peljesac Peninsula.

Day 1 – Friday – October 14 - Arrive in Split (Croatia) (Dinner)

Arrive in Split today. We are welcomed at the airport and transferred to our hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Enjoy a welcome dinner & briefing this evening at a local restaurant.

Day 2 – Saturday – October 15 - SPLIT - MAKARSKA (Breakfast,Lunch)

This morning we enjoy a guided tour of Split, a monumental city under UNESCO protection. The city features an abundance of Roman architecture; of special interest is the Diocletian palace. The tour will end in the harbor in front of the ship, where we check-in for the cruise. Luggage transfer will be arranged from the hotel. Departure from the Split harbor is at 1:00pm. We cruise along the Dalmatian coast towards Makarska whilst enjoying lunch. For the adrenaline lovers, there's an optional zip line ride over the Cetina river canyon. Overnight in Makarska, the famous tourist destination with many restaurants and bars and a beautiful promenade along the famous beach. Enjoy the magic of Makarska Riviera and be sure to take a walk along the city streets – with an abundance of churches and other cultural sites.

Day 3 – Sunday – October 16 - MAKARSKA - BOL (BRAČ) - STARI GRAD (Breakfast, Lunch)

In the morning, we cruise towards the island of Brač, more precisely to the town of Bol, known for its famous Zlatni Rat beach (Golden Horn), a natural phenomenon that dominates the other beaches with its specific form. After lunch, we continue our journey towards Stari Grad on Hvar island, the sunniest Adriatic island. Free afternoon to explore this unique town. The famous Stari Grad Field is the oldest in Croatia and the best-preserved example of an ancient Greek system of agriculture. Together with the old town, it is a part of world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in one of the ports of Stari Grad, main or ferry port(2 km away) depending on availability in the port.

Day 4 – Monday – October 17 - STARI GRAD - HVAR (Breakfast, Lunch)

The next destination is the town of Hvar, a favorite destination for jet setters from all around the world. Arrive at Hvar in the afternoon hours followed by a guided tour of this extraordinary town. Hvar offers many cultural and historical sites such as the Renaissance cathedral, the oldest communal theatre in Europe founded in 1612, Franciscan monastery, the Benedictine convent famous for their lace listed on the UNESCO World Heritage list, Spanjola fortress towering high above the town and many restaurants and bars open late into the night.

Day 5 –Tuesday – October 18 - HVAR - (Blue cave) VIS (Breakfast, Lunch)

Early in the morning, we cruise towards the little Biševo island to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of our visit will depend on those conditions. Entrance to Blue Cave is to be paid on the spot (approx. EUR 14.- per person). We continue towards the island of Vis, which was a strategic navy harbor due to its unique geographical position and as such closed to the public until recently. Because of its isolation, Vis has a special charm which makes it so interesting. Overnight is in the town of Vis, situated on the northern side of the island, developed near the remains of the ancient Issa, the first urban center in Croatia. If interested, visit the remains of the Roman thermal Place, City museum or simply take a walk enjoying the view of beautiful "Villae Rusticae" situated along the coast.

Day 6 – Wednesday – October 19 - VIS - KORČULA (Breakfast, Lunch)

During breakfast, we depart towards Korčula, the birthplace of the famous explorer and adventurer Marco Polo. Surrounded by medieval walls, Korčula resembles a miniature Dubrovnik when approaching from the sea. It has more legends, tales, and monuments than you will find anywhere else. Today, Korčula is the only place in the world where the Spanish medieval knight's game – Moreška is still performed. Upon arrival, we enjoy a guided walking tour through the streets of the old town built in the shape of a fishbone (included on Premium Superior). Enjoy the numerous konobas / taverns, restaurants, cocktail bars, or nightclubs located within and around the city walls. Overnight in port.

Day 7 – Thursday – October 20 - KORČULA - MLJET - ŠIPAN or SLANO (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Cruising continues towards one of the greenest Adriatic islands – the island of Mljet, where on the western part, the Mljet National Park is situated. Free time to enjoy the beauties of the National Park. Two salt lakes are connected to the sea by a narrow channel. Take a boat ride to the St Mary isle in the Great Lake, where the old church and monastery are situated. The cruise resumes towards Šipan, part of Elaphite islands near Dubrovnik, or towards Slano on the coastline. Both are small fishermen's villages, in one of which we will stay overnight in the port and have the Captain's dinner onboard.

Day 8 – Friday – October 21 - ŠIPAN or SLANO - DUBROVNIK (Breakfast, Lunch)

Early in the morning, we depart towards our final destination – a true pearl of the Adriatic. Enjoy a guided tour of Dubrovnik followed by a cable car ride up to Srđ mountain for spectacular views of the old town. We recommend a stroll along the city walls, 2000 yards in length with magnificent views of the old town of Dubrovnik and the surrounding islands. Overnight in the harbor Gruž.

Day 9 – Saturday – October 22 – DUBROVNIK – MONTENEGRO – DUBROVNIK (Breakfast, Lunch)

Today awaits disembarkation in the Dubrovnik port. Proceed on a full day coach excursion to Montenegro - a small country with magnificent mountains rising above the Adriatic Sea, filled with natural beauty, clear lakes, fast rivers and serene beaches. Enjoy exploring Montenegro's contrasting nature attractions, interesting history, culture, tradition, and clean air. We return to Dubrovnik this evening and check in at our hotel.

Day 10 – Sunday – October 23 – DUBROVNIK – PELJESAC PENINSULA – DUBROVNIK (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast we depart on an excursion to the nearby Pelješac peninsula, famous as the home to Plavac Mali wine, an ancestor of California Zinfandel. On route we will stop in the town of Ston, where we have a chance to visit the city walls and hear about the salt production in this town. We will visit two wineries on the peninsula and taste local wines, accompanied with some snacks and mussels.

6:30 pm: Farewell dinner at Restaurant Poklisar

Day 11 – Monday – October 24 - DUBROVNIK – USA (Breakfast)

Depending on flight departure check-out from the hotel. Transfer to the Dubrovnik airport.

Day 2 – Tuesday – October 25 - Venice (Breakfast)

Venice: Walking tour, The Doge's Palaces and Golden Basilica

Make the most of your stay in Venice and discover the most iconic landmarks on a combined tour of this wonderful city.

Highlights

- Stroll through the heart of Venice
- Marvel the opulence of Doge's Palace
- Roam around the most majestic cathedral in Venice: The Golden Basilica

What better way to get our bearings of the city than a delightful walking tour through the heart of Venice. Begin with an eye-opening stroll at the magnificent Piazza San Marco, one of the most famous plazas in the world. Admire spectacular architecture such as the Basilica di San Marco, the 15th-century Clock Tower, adorned by 2 bronze figures which strike the bell hourly and much more. Head off towards the Piazza Santa Maria Formosa, another square popular with the locals and discover Venice's most interesting buildings such as Marco Polo's home and even the Pantheon of Venice. Top off the walking tour with a stroll through the Mercerie, home to boutiques and high-end designer stores.

Pass through the famous arches of Doge's Palace as you start your second tour, where you will discover the opulence, grandeur and beauty of this Venetian Palace. As you wander through the different rooms, behold the priceless ornaments and exquisite decor and lavish paintings. Cross the famous Bridge of Sighs and relive the anguish that the prisoners endured before delving into the sinister prisons, where the legendary Giacomo Casanova was held.

The final tour, and one not to be missed is the Basilica di San Marco: The Golden Basilica, by far the most

majestic cathedral in Venice. We discover the interior of this masterpiece of byzantine art and feast our eyes on the shimmering golden mosaics and marble inlays.

Duration: 4 Hours

Day 3 – Wednesday – October 26 - Venice (Breakfast)

Murano glass blowing and Burano lace making

Join us on a fascinating half-day trip to the timeless islands of Murano and Burano and discover traditional crafts that have survived the passing of time.

On the short boat trip over to the islands we admire the beautiful views and be entertained by our guide with a description of the sights as we pass them. In no time at all, we arrive at pretty Murano famed for its glass blowing. Once upon a time, the glassblowers here were the only people in Europe who knew how to create mirrors and their skills were so valued that they were banned from leaving the city of Venice under threat of execution. Watch a craftsman in action as he goes about his daily business, and browse the huge collection of glass art before strolling around the island.

Then back to the boat and off to our next stop, Burano, a tiny picturesque island famous for its colored houses and its centuries-old tradition of lace-making. Huddled tightly together along streets and canals, each house is painted a different color. Legend has it that fishermen started this trend, painting their houses in bright shades so that they could distinguish it from a distance.

We wander through the streets to a small building where women sit working feverishly, stitching lace like their mothers and grandmothers before them. Stay and watch their painstaking work, listen to a full commentary on what, in the age of sewing machines, has become a dying art, and then take the time to examine the beautiful lace samples on display.
