10 Days: CAIRO- NILE RIVER CRUISE- LUXOR - ASWAN & ABU SIMBEL

Tour Overview

Egypt is a nation of epic history. Enjoy this land as the pictures you've seen in books come to life before your eyes. Walk down the paths of pharaohs in Cairo, stand in the shadow of gargantuan pyramids in Giza. From Luxor you cruise down the mystical Nile River. In Aswan we visit a Nubian Village. We also fly to Abu Simbel to visit the iconic temple and statues of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari.

Day 1: Sunday Dec. 4 - Arrive Cairo – Welcome Dinner

Arrive to Cairo, Egypt, where you are met and transferred to your hotel. This evening meet your tour director for a tour briefing followed by our welcome dinner at the hotel. (D)

4 night stay at The Marriott Historical Mena House Hotel, Garden Section

Set amidst 40 acres of verdant gardens, this stunning hotel offers 331 plush rooms and suites offering spectacular views of the mighty Giza Pyramids and the surrounding lush greenery. Leisure facilities include an outdoor heated pool, Health Club and Spa.

Day 2: Monday Dec. 5 - Cairo - Giza Pyramids & Sphinx

This morning we meet our dedicated English-speaking Egyptologist Guide who will accompany us throughout the tour. Today we visit the Great Pyramids of Giza, including the Pyramid of Khufu and the Sphinx. Lunch at a local restaurant. Afternoon at leisure. (BL)

Day 3: Tuesday Dec 6 - Cairo - City Sightseeing & Egyptian Museum

Explore the ancient city of Cairo, including the Citadel, the Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali and the colorful Khan el Khalili Bazaar. We'll also visit the spice market and the antiques market and have lunch at a local restaurant. Spend the afternoon viewing antiquities at the Egyptian Museum. (BL)

Day 4: Wednesday Dec. 7 - Cairo – Memphis & Saqqara

This morning we visit Memphis, once a vast metropolis and capital of the Old Kingdom. Continue to Saqqara, the oldest stone complex in the world, to see the towering Step Pyramid of Djoser, the earliest

of all pyramids. Lunch at the new restaurant overlooking the pyramids with the balance of the day at leisure. (BL)

Day 5: Thursday Dec. 8 - Cairo / Luxor – Nile Cruise

Transfer to Cairo Airport for the morning scheduled domestic flight to Luxor (flight included). Arrive and board your Nile cruise ship, our home for the next four nights as we cruise the majestic and mystical Nile River. This afternoon we tour Luxor's East Bank and the impressive Karnak Temple. In the evening we visit the illuminated Luxor Temple. (BLD)

Day 6: Friday - Dec. 9 - Nile River Cruise – West Bank & Home Hosted Lunch / Edfu

This morning visit Luxor's West Bank - Valley of the Kings and Queens, the Temple of Hatshepsut and Colossus of Memnon. A traditional Egyptian lunch is arranged with a local family in their home. Afternoon set sail to Edfu. (BLD)

Day 7: Saturday - Dec.10 - Nile River Cruise – Edfu / Kom Ombo / Aswan

This morning visit the temple of Horus in Edfu, one of the well-preserved temples of Ancient Egypt and built to honor the falcon headed God. This visit is by horse carriage. We continue our cruise to Kom Ombo. Cooking class onboard followed by lunch. Afternoon visit the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo, then continue to cruise to Aswan. (BLD)

Day 8: Sunday - Dec 11 - Nile Cruise – Aswan & Nubian Village

Morning visit the elegant Temple of Philae followed by the unfinished Obelisk. Afternoon enjoy a scenic felucca ride on the Nile and visit a Nubian Village where we are invited for tea inside one of the homes. Meet with women and learn more about the culture and see their handicrafts. (BLD)

Day 9: Monday - Dec. 12 - Nile Cruise – Aswan High Dam / Abu Simble / Cairo

Morning check out and proceed with a visit to the Aswan High Dam en route to the airport. Depart on Scheduled flight to Abu Simbel (flight included). Upon arrival, visit the magnificent Temples of Ramses II & Nefertari. We then depart on the scheduled domestic flight to Cairo (flight included). Arrive and transfer to our hotel located near the airport and connected to a mall which affords last minute shopping opportunities including Egyptian made souvenirs and product. This evening we will have a farewell dinner at the hotel. (BD)

1 night stay at InterContinental Citystars Cairo

InterContinental Citystars Cairo offers luxury in the buzzing hub of Heliopolis, next to Stars Centre Mall. The hotel puts everything at your fingertips, from steak to sushi, from spa treatments to squash and from advanced conference facilities to cocktails at the poolside bar.

Day 10: Tuesday - Dec. 13 - Depart Cairo

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight. (B)

Day 10: Tuesday – Dec. 13 - Cairo / Alexandria -

Mid-morning pick up by your private car with driver/guide for the journey to Alexandria (approx 3 hours). This afternoon visit Bibliotheca Alexandria (Alexandria Library). (B)

1 night stay at Steigenberger Cecil Hotel, partial sea view room

Since its opening in 1929, Steigenberger Cecil Hotel in Alexandria has been known for its superb location right on the harbour. It is just a short walk to many of the city’s famous sights such as the Biblioteca Alexandrina, the Alexandria National Museum, and the Amphitheater. All rooms have separately programmable air conditioning, TV with international channels, a desk, safe, and minibar, as well as complimentary coffee and tea making facilities.

Day 11: Wednesday – Dec 14. - Alexandria - City Sightseeing / Cairo

Full day tour on private basis with English-Speaking Egyptologist guide. First visit the Catacombs. This family tomb shows the merging of Egyptian and Roman art and architecture. You’ll see Pompey’s Pillar built to honor Emperor Diocletian who had freed Alexandria. After visiting the Roman Theatre we will have a lunch stop (own account). On to the Citadel of Qaitbay in the Mediterranean Sea. Built in the 15th century by Sultan al-Ashraf Qu’it Bay. Photos stops of Abu el Abbas Mosque and the unknown soldier monument. Late afternoon return to Cairo. (B)

1 night stay at InterContinental Citystars Cairo

Day 12: Thursday – Dec 15. - Depart Cairo

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight. (B)

Visas: US Passport holders require visas for Egypt **U.S. citizens can obtain a renewable single-entry 30-day tourist visa on arrival at Egyptian airports for a 25 USD fee. A multiple entry visa is also obtainable for 60 USD. The Government of Egypt has created a website for the issuance of “e-visas” at visa2egypt.gov.eg/eVisa/Home.** There are other websites purporting to offer electronic visas, but this is the only official Government of Egypt portal for this service Please ensure that your passport is valid for 6 months from return date.

Inoculations: We recommend that you contact Passport Health at 1-888-499 7277 or www.passporthealthusa.com for questions regarding country-specific health counseling.

Tour Reservations: SITA requires a deposit of \$600 per person to commence reservations. This amount will be adjusted with the balance due 90 days prior to departure.
