



Petra with Jordan: Amman, Mt. Nebo and More (Pre or Post Egypt 2022)

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Day 01 Arrive Amman Dinner

Meet and assist upon arrival at Queen Alia International airport, where we will be waiting to meet and assist through all customs and immigration formalities. Once formalities and the luggage have been identified, we will be led to the private vehicle to be transferred to the hotel. Room will be available from 1400hrs

Overnight at: INTERCONTINENTAL HOTEL

Day 02 Amman / Madaba / Mt. Nebo / Kerak / Petra - Hotel BLD

The morning is dedicated to the sites of Madaba and Mt. Nebo. **Madaba**, a small town at the head of the ancient King's Highway (40 minutes from Amman), is covered with fantastic mosaics from the Byzantine era. Many are located in private homes, discovered when owners dug foundations or gardens. At St. George's Cathedral, we see the most famous of all - a clearly-labeled mosaic map of Jerusalem and the surrounding areas dated 560 A.D., which helped archaeologists to identify important sites in Jordan. **Mt. Nebo** is west of Madaba, on a cliff overlooking the Jordan Valley and Dead Sea. Long believed to be the burial place of Moses, Mount Nebo has impressive mosaics and other remains 4-6 A.D. churches, monasteries and hermitages, now maintained by Franciscan priests living nearby. Continue further south to the village of **Kerak, Lunch** at local restaurant in the city followed by a visit to the famous castle It lies in the biblical land of Moab and was a Moabite stronghold long before the Crusaders built the castle for which it is famous today. Although it was not the first crusader's castle to be built

east of Jordan, its strength and location made Kerak the most important defenses guarding the Latin Kingdom's exposed eastern flank. End the visit then transfer directly to the hotel in Petra.

Overnight at: MOVENPICK HOTEL

Day 03 Petra visit / Amman BLD

Checkout the hotel and start a full day visit to explore the legendary rose-red city of Petra. Petra is the legacy of the Nabataeans, an industrious Arab people who settled in southern Jordan more than 2,000 years ago. Most of the 800 monuments in Petra are carved out of solid rock. See the spectacular Treasury, the 8,000-seat amphitheater, the Temple of the Winged Lions and other monuments. Lunch at a local restaurant. Later, return to Amman. (BLD)
