7 Days: *Athens, Corinth Canal, Epidauros, Nafplion, Mycenae, Olympia, Delphi, Aegina, Poros & Hydra*

Tour Overview

This tour starts in Athens with a panoramic tour of the historic landmarks of the city. Next, a guided visit to the Acropolis to see the temple of Athena Nike, the Parthenon, and more. Stops will be made in Peloponneseto see the Corinth canal, Nafplion, and Mycenae. Experience the wonders of the Ancient Olympia Complex, where the original Olympic Games were held. Delphi is up next for a day full of admiring the amazing sights and learn the history. For the last full day, the tour will transfer to the port of Trokadero for a day cruise to the islands of the Saronic gulf – a day full of adventures that are one of a kind!

Day 1 – SUN, 13 NOV 22: Arrival / Athens (D)

Arrive at the Athens airport, welcome assistance, and transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. In the evening we will gather again and after a briefing about our tour, we will head at a local restaurant for our welcome dinner. Return transfer to the hotel for overnight.

Day 2 – MON, 14 NOV 22: Athens city tour / Athens (B,L)

The day is dedicated to exploring the city of Athens. Our day begins with a direct transfer for our guided visit to the Acropolis, including the Propylae, the temple of Athena Nike, the Parthenon, the Erechtheion. From here, we continue on foot along Diorysiou Aeropagitou street, to the Acropolis museum, voted on of the best museums in Europe, where findings from the area, including the Caryatides have found their home. We will then board our coach again and continue with a panoramic tour to the most important monuments and landmarks of the city including the Panathinaikon stadium, the Zappeion, the temple of

Olympian Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, Syntagma square, the Parliament, the tomb of the unknown soldier, Schliemann's house, the Academy, the University, the National Library, and the old Parliament. Our panoramic tour will end in Kerameikos area. The day continues on foot to the local Farmer's market for a vibrant slice-of-life experience, mingling with the locals who buy fresh foodie products from various local producers. Further walk, will bring us to Thisio. Taking Adrianou street and walking next to the ancient Greek and Roman agora, we will cross to Monastiraki with the famous flea market, and conclude in Plaka to experience a typical Greek lunch with "souvlaki with pita", Greek salad and appetizers. Balance of the afternoon at leisure to explore Plaka, the picturesque old part of the city, and why not, some shopping at Ermou street.

Day 3 – TUE, 15 NOV 22: Corinth Canal, Epidaurus, Nafplion, Mycenae / Olympia (B,D)

After our breakfast, we depart towards the Peloponnese. The first stop will be at the impressive Corinth canal and we continue to Epidaurus with its theater, famous for its acoustics. Our day continues as we will be arriving in Nafplion for a short stop. Our next visit will be to Mycenae «rich in gold» as Homer mentions, with the Cyclopean walls, and the tomb of Agamemnon with the famous Lion's Gate. In the afternoon, we will be crossing the mountains of the Peloponnese to arrive in Olympia for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 – WED, 16 NOV 22: Olympia / Delphi (B,L,D)

Built on the banks of the River Alfios, Olympia is beautiful, green, and placid. We will enjoy a tour through the remains of the Ancient Olympia Complex (home of the original Olympic Games), including the Temple of Zeus, the Palaestra, and Phidias's Workshop. We continue to the local museum, one of the richest in Greece, with the impressive statue of Hermes of Praxitelis. Lunch on the way. In the afternoon, we will start heading north, driving around Patras, over the impressive Rio-Antirio bridge, through Nafpaktos and Itea, to Delphi for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – THU, 17 NOV 22: Delphi / Athens (B,L,D)

Delphi used to be the most sacred spot in the world and a pilgrimage center for many centuries in antiquity. You will admire the Sanctuary of Apollo, walk the Sacred way, and visit the temple of Apollo, home of Pythia (the oracle). We continue to the local museum with the famous bronze statue of the Charioteer. After our visits, we will take the road back towards Athens. On the way, we will stop for lunch at a countryside local restaurant. Arrival in Athens in the afternoon and check in at our hotel. In the evening, we will gather and head to a local restaurant with live Greek music to experience a dinner along with the locals.

Day 6 – FRI, 18 NOV 22: Day cruise to Aegina, Poros & Hydra / Athens (B,L,D)

Early breakfast this morning and we transfer to the port for a day cruise to the islands of the Saronic gulf. Our first port of call will be Hydra. A picturesque little “vehicle-free” island, well-known to the international jet-set. Take a donkey ride, explore the little cobble-stoned streets, and visit the Mitropolis at your own pace. Next, we will be visiting the island of Poros with its clock tower facing the Peloponnese. Last will be a visit to Aegina, a weekend retreat island for many Athenians. Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride. Before leaving make sure to buy some pistachios, as Aegina is world-famous for its production. During cruising, you will enjoy a buffet lunch on board, and on the way back you will have to opportunity to see and participate in some traditional Greek dances! Return transfer to our hotel, where we will enjoy a farewell dinner with great views to the Acropolis.

Day 7 – SAT, 19 NOV 22: Departure (B)

Breakfast, and at the appropriate time, transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

The Santorini Classic Highlights Tour concludes with Santorini’s most treasured moments as we will take you to the village of Oia to enjoy the magnificent sunset! Embark on a tour that will take you only to the best of Santorini!

Many historic mansions, old traditional houses, pirate hideouts and wine cannons. Traders and rich landowners who exported the famous wine of the island, Vishanto, lived here in its history. An important feature of these historic houses and mansions are the high walls, courtyards, and large imposing wooden doors that were built to protect privacy and security for pirates.

The Red Beach is behind a series of lava monoliths! A rare beach that you should definitely visit. Its distinctive morphological character, make the Red Beach one of the most captivating beaches in the world. Emporio was the place where all the merchandise was sold in the past - which shows that the production of the products was here. The most important attraction is the medieval Kastelli, a masterpiece of architecture, which is in very good condition as many buildings have been restored or repaired by their owners, although they are not inhabited all year.

Perissa, located at the south-eastern end of the island, stretching about 7 km, is the largest beach of Santorini, with its continuation, Perivolos and Saint George. With black sand, clear deep waters and well-organized beach bars, tavernas and cafés right on the beach, Perissa accommodates any visitor who prefers something more economical in terms of accommodation and entertainment than the Caldera settlements.

The highest point of Santorini with excellent views not only of Santorini but also of the surrounding islands. The entrance to the courtyard of the monastery is a beautiful experience. The temple has a tranquil serenity and if all areas are open you will be impressed by the relics and historical manuscripts. The most photographed Santorini blue domes churches are located in Oia. You'll have the chance to visit and take the most wonderful pictures of your trip.
