Discover Oman's port capital of Muscat, Nizwa's impressive fort, picturesque highland villages, and Salalah's Frankincense trail of UNESCO heritage. Along the way, share a meal with an Emirati cultural ambassador, stroll the sougs, and learn about Bedouin culture.

- Enjoy spectacular views from the tallest building in the world, the Burj Khalifa in Dubai.

- Learn about the ancient UNESCO-listed aflaj irrigation system in Misfat Al Abriyeen, one of Oman's most beautiful villages.
- Experience the unique climate of Salalah in the Dhofar Mountains and greenery of Wadi Darbat.

UAE & Oman - Day by Day Itinerary

Days 1-3: Dubai & Abu Dhabi, UAE

Arrive in Dubai and then explore this unique city from the oldest historical district to its newer architectural landmarks. In addition to visiting the beautiful Jumeirah Mosque, share a traditional Emirati meal at the Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding. Discover Abu Dhabi, the capital of UAE, from the marble domes of the Qasr Al Watan Presidential Palace, to the wonderous Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, which can accommodate nearly 50,000 worshippers, to the Louvre Abu Dhabi housed in an ornate geometric building. *Courtyard by Marriott Al Barsha or similar in Dubai. Pearl Rotana Capital Centre or similar in Abu Dhabi. [2B, 2L, 2D]*

Days 4-5: Muscat, Oman

Fly on to Muscat, Oman. The combination of historic souqs, traditional whitewashed architecture, and old-school hospitality give Muscat arguably the most charm and authentic character of any capital on the Arabian Peninsula. Explore the grounds of the Sultan's Palace, the dazzling Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque and the Mutfah Souq. *Sheraton Oman Hotel or similar. [2B, 1L, 1D]*

Days 6-7: Wahiba Sands & Jebel Akhdar

Driving along the scenic coastal road, stop at Bimmah Sinkhole and dip your toes in a crystal-clear pool 90 feet below the ground. Arrive at Wahiba Sands, an immense dune field, in time to enjoy sunset and spend a night glamping under the stars at a remote desert camp. Then drive on to Jebel Akhdar, one of the highest mountains on the Arabian Peninsula, exploring local villages on foot. Desert Nights Camp or similar in Wahiba Sands. DusitD2 Naseem Resort or similar in Jebel Akhdar. [2B, 2L, 1D]

Day 8: Nizwa

The town of Nizwa is located at the crossroads of ancient trade routes. Visit Oman's most visited national monument, Nizwa Fort, strategically placed on a hilltop overlooking the colorful domes and bustling markets of the city below. *Golden Tulip or similar. [1B, 1L]*

Day 9: Al Hamra

Stop by the UNESCO listed Bahla Fort and majestic Jibreen Castle en route to Al Hamra, a small mountainside town on the slopes of Jebel Shams. Experience Omani folklore, handicrafts and demonstrations at the Bait Al Safah Museum before visiting the beautiful village of Misfat Al Abriyeen. *Sheraton Oman Hotel or similar. [1B, 1L]*

Days 10-12: Salalah

Fly to Salalah, Oman's greenest region, dotted with coconut palms, Baobabs, and tropical crops. Let your nose guide you through the Haffah Souq, filled with frankincense and perfume, and learn more about the frankincense trail at the Museum of the Land of Frankincense. Depart home. *Millennium Resort Salalah or similar [3B, 2L]*
