DAY1 (NOV 6): ARRIVAL IN LIMA

DAY 4 (NOV 9): FROM LIMA TO CUSCO & THE SACRED VALLEY

After breakfast, bid farewell to Lima as we embark on a journey to Cusco. Upon arrival, we're greeted with a warm welcome at Hacienda Sarapampa, where generations of tradition come alive. Delve into the culinary legacy of the Sacred Valley with a lunch that celebrates local organic produce. Our exploration continues with a visit to the quaint town of Pisac, where Incan and Colonial influences converge in a tapestry of culture and craftsmanship.

DAY 5 (NOV 10): SACRED VALLEY DISCOVERIES

Morning begins with breakfast at the hotel. Continue to experience the heartbeat of the Sacred Valley with a morning visit to Urubamba's vibrant farmers market, followed by a glimpse into the time-honored craft of hat making with Elvira Argandoña. DAY 6 (NOV 11): SACRED VALLEY TO MACHU PICCHU

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ancient civilizations. Explore the majestic Ollantaytambo fortress before boarding a scenic train ride to Aguas Calientes. DAY 7 (NOV 12): MACHU PICCHU TO CUSCO
