#### Arles: Arles and its history (walking tour)

You will be able to explore the impressive amphitheater of Arles during your visit. It was once the site of gladiator fights, animal hunts and other public events.



### Avignon: The Pearl of the Rhône (walking tour)

Stroll through the Garden of the Popes, the Rocher des Doms, with its beautiful terraces and visit the imposing Papal Palace.



### Martigues: Discover Marseille (bus-walking tour)

The walk to the Basilica Notre-Dame de la Garde, which is perched on a 162-meter-high hill, worthwhile - and is rewarded with a fantastically beautiful view of the city.



# Viviers: Ardèche Gorges and Lavender Museum (bus-walking tour)

At the first stop on your journey, visit the Lavender Museum and learn more about the plant that transforms Provence into a purple sea of beguiling scents every summer.
